Parking in the vicinity of PGS

The Council have confirmed that they will continue to honour their proposals of April 2009 as outlined below.

Mornings

Parents and Guardians of children at the School/Nursery will be able to park in the pay and display areas up to 09.15 during term time free of charge. The notices at these parking areas will not be changed. In addition, parents and guardians may use the Coach bays in Museum Road to drop children off. This concession is available in Museum Road and Pembroke Road only.

Afternoons

No change to current arrangements. The charges must be paid to park in pay and display areas.

Pedestrian Safety in Museum Road and the High Street

It is crucial to remind all parents that the parking restrictions around school such as double yellow lines and zigzag lines will be rigorously enforced to ensure that roads are kept safe and free of accidents. The area outside the main Archway must not be used for dropping off or collecting pupils at anytime. This is one of the greatest risks to pupil safety and the school coaches also must be able to pull in here from the main flow of traffic.

We have been clearly informed that the Police will take measures against motorists who infringe traffic regulations at this point, and we would ask for parental co-operation in the interests of the safety of all.
