I am writing to formally invite you and your son or daughter to attend the Sixth Form Subject Forum evening on Monday 9 January between 6.30 pm and 8.00pm. As you may have heard, this event is designed to give pupils in Year 11 and their parents the opportunity to meet Heads of Department to discuss subject choices for A Level and IB in the Sixth Form at Portsmouth Grammar School.

Members of staff will be available at subject stands in the Dining Hall and David Russell Theatre throughout the evening and will be joined by current Sixth Form pupils who will be able to give an insight into studying the subject. The Deputy Head (Academic), Mrs Louise Wilson, will be on hand if there are any queries relating to subject combinations.
