The Middle School production this year is the play version of the popular musical *Blood Brothers*. It tells the story of twin brothers in Liverpool who are separated at birth and unaware of each others existence. One brother is brought up by his real mother whilst the other is brought up by the much wealthier Mrs Lyons. The play follows their life as children, teenagers and adults and was originally written to be played by the same actors. In our version different actors play the characters at different ages and also many of the parts are double cast so, depending on the night you come, you will see a different cast performing. There is also a large chorus who comment and react to the events unfolding.

The show will start at 7.30pm on Wednesday 25, Thursday 26 and Friday 27 May and runs for 1 hour 15 minutes without an interval. Drinks will be served from 7.00pm. The play is very funny and moving but ultimately tragic and does contain some strong language.
