**Casual Clothes Day in aid of the Uganda 2010 Expedition Community Projects

This summer, a team of 23 pupils will be travelling to Uganda on a four week expedition. The trip will include two community projects, where pupils will be involved in activities for which building materials are required. Both of these projects are at schools, one of which is Kikaaya College with whom we already have an established link.

We are pleased to announce that there will be a non-uniform day on Thursday 29 April in aid of these worthwhile international projects. The money raised will be used to buy materials in Uganda so that they are available when the expedition team arrive. **Pupils who wish to wear casual clothes will be required to bring £2 prior to or on the day itself.** Money should be handed in to Tutors.

Casual clothes are to be clean, non-offensive and sensible for school activities. Unacceptable hair styles, fancy dress and scruffy clothing will not be acceptable. The future of such events requires all pupils to be mindful of these principles. The normal running of the school is paramount.
