Year 9 Play in a Day – ‘One Thousand and One Nights’ – Monday 11 July

I write to invite you to an evening of entertainment and fun in the David Russell Theatre on Monday 11 July at 7.30pm.

All Year 9 pupils will be taking part in a PGS Drama Department production of ‘*One Thousand and One Nights*’ perhaps more commonly known as the ‘*Arabian Nights*’. They will spend the whole day working together in their tutor groups alongside members of staff to produce a series of eight 15 minute pieces (one per tutor group) for the stage.

Pupils will be able to take part in a number of activities during the day and examples of these include, performing on stage, helping to make props with the Technology Department, producing programmes with the Art Department, composing live music for the show and sourcing and making costumes. It promises to be a great night.

There are several logistical issues that need your attention please:

- If you are unable to attend the evening performance then pupils will need to be collected from school after the performance (2145) or other arrangements made for them to go home
- Pupils will be given an evening meal (1700)

Tickets for the evening are available from the Senior School Reception although please note that numbers are limited, so do book early to avoid disappointment.
