- Grades for effort and attainment are awarded termly
- There are also overall comments on the child written by the form teacher and the Headmistress
- In the summer term a full written report is given on each subject
- In the autumn and spring terms there is a Parents' Evening immediately following receipt of the reports to discuss their content
- In the summer a feedback form is included for parents on which to record comments

KS1 Effort Grades

The grade awarded will be a best fit from the following:

VG Grade-consistently

- Works independently and always tries their best
- Remains on task for sustained periods of time
- Produces work of a very high standard

G Grade-generally

- Works with greater independence and tries their best
- Remains on task for longer periods of time
- Producing work of a good standard

S Grade-satisfactorily

- Beginning to work with independence
- Remains on task when prompted
- Producing work of a satisfactory standard

F Grade-infrequently

- Works independently- needing support
- Remains on task- needing support
- Participates in class discussions
- Produces finished independent work

U Grade- Generally cannot

- Remain on task
- Work without support
- Produce finished work

GUIDANCE FOR EFFORT GRADES KS2

The grade awarded will be a best fit from the following:

Grade A pupils have *consistently*

- * displayed a high level of commitment within all areas of the subject, working with sustained concentration
- * produced classwork of a high level of care, presented correctly
- * produced homework of a high level of care, always handed in on time
- * had the appropriate equipment for the lesson

Grade B pupils have *generally*

- * worked well in class with sustained concentration
- * produced classwork of a very good level of care with correct layout
- * produced homework of a very good level of care, handed in on time
- * had the appropriate equipment for the lesson
- * produced classwork of a good level of care with the correct layout

Grade C pupils have *satisfactorily*,

- * produced class work
- * produced homework of a good level of care, usually handed in on time
- * had the appropriate equipment for the lesson

Grade D pupils have *infrequently*

- * produced satisfactory classwork,
- * produced adequate homework, generally handed in late after teacher's request
- * had the appropriate equipment for the lesson

Grade E pupils *generally*

- * are inattentive or disruptive in class
- * produce classwork that is incomplete
- * fail to produce homework
- * fail to have the appropriate equipment for the lesson
