OP CLUB TRAVEL AWARDS

- 1. The Old Portmuthian Club can award funds to:
 - Pupils at The Portsmouth Grammar School aged 16 or over; and
 - OPs aged between 16 and 23 who are still in full time education;

to enable them to undertake activity of an educational, medical, social welfare, community development, environmental, scientific, or volunteer nature in the UK or overseas.

- 2. Applications should be sent to the Honorary Secretary of the OP Club, via the Development Office at PGS, on development@pgs.org.uk
- 3. Applications for a grant are accepted throughout the year
- 4. Applicants should submit:
 - a. A letter of application describing the purpose of the activity and indicating the total amount involved
 - b. A budget
 - c. CV
 - d. A reference from The Portsmouth Grammar School or their place of further education
 - e. Details of other sources of funds (including other grants sought)
- 5. The proposed travel must have some significance and purpose beyond purely personal enjoyment. Consideration will be taken into:
 - a. How the trip will help with your personal/professional development
 - b. How the trip will benefit others
 - c. Any voluntary work undertaken and how this will impact on the local community
 - d. How the trip will enhance your work experience or education.
- 6. Confirmation of the travel arrangements (e.g. a booking confirmation from the airline) is required to trigger the release of the grant.
- 7. If the individual does not subsequently undertake the planned activity, the OP Club may ask for the award to be refunded.
- 8. The welfare of any individual undertaking any activity funded by an Old Portmuthian grant is entirely the responsibility of that individual. The Old Portmuthian grant is a purely financial arrangement.
- 9. A written report (approx. 3 pages A4) is required within a month of the completion of the activity. The report should include the following.
 - Description of the travel experience where it was, what it involved, activities.
 - A summary of what was gained from the travel experience in terms of personal development and acquiring new skills (e.g. working in a team, leadership etc.), broadening horizons and the impact on future plans and ambitions.
 - How others benefitted from the trip.
 - Photos.
